The Metropolitan Sewer District's Sustainable Infrastructure Program is using the Lick Run Watershed as a focus area for evaluating the use of both gray and green infrastructure as ways to improve the community and still meet its Combined Sewer Overflow management needs. The Lick Run Watershed focus area is located west of the Mill Creek and includes South Fairmount and the Western Hills Viaduct.

RA Consultants, LLC provided surveying and data management services per the Lick Run Wet Weather Strategy-Stage 2 Sewer Separation Design. Having already performed survey services for Phase 1 of this project, RA was prepared and knowledgeable of the intended scope of work and project location.

RA worked diligently in the field to investigate and reinvestigate undocumented structures related to the project area's storm and sanitary sewer infrastructure. Under Phase 1, survey and structure investigations were performed for nearly 2,800 structures spanning over 123,000 feet (23.3 miles) of sewer. RA offered field support by providing aerial mapping field verification and performed confined space entry as needed.
